- VIOLATION IS A MISTAMENOR, FINE NO GREATER THAN \$1000
- NEW MEXICO SB497 SCOOBY'S LAW PASSED, PAINFULL DEATH TO ANIMALS WHO INGEST ANTIFREEZE. PRESTONE ANTIFREEZE SUPPORTED THE PASSAGE OF THE NEW MEXICO BILL
- PENNSYLVANIA, NEW YORK HAVE SIGNED UP FOR SAME BILL PASSAGE
- WOULD RAISE COST OF ANTIFREEZE .03 CENTS /GALLON
