JUDGMENT ENTRY & ORDER

Upon the evidence presented, the Court finds there are no genuine issues of material fact and the moving party is entitled to a judgment, as a matter of law, and the motion for summary judgment filed by the plaintiff is granted.

As to the claims of Ohio Board of Motor Vehicle Collision Repair Registration and against Ron Luman, Jeff Gaines and William White, judgment is entered in favor of plaintiff.

Plaintiff Ohio Board of Motor Vehicle Collision Registration is granted permanent injunctive relief, as follows:

Ron Luman, dba Rapid Auto Body; Jeff Gaines, dba Jeff's Auto Body; and William White, dba Fender Mender, are prohibited from acting or operating as a motor vehicle collision repair shop.

The defendants may regain the right to operate if they come into compliance with Ohio law, including all of the regulations of the Board of Motor Vehicle Collision Registration.

The trial set for 5/3/07 is canceled.

Costs to be paid by equally by Ron Luman, Jeff Gaines and William White.

This is a final, appealable order.
